


**PUBLIC PLACE NAMES ACT 1989**

Dated the 30<sup>th</sup> day of June 1993.





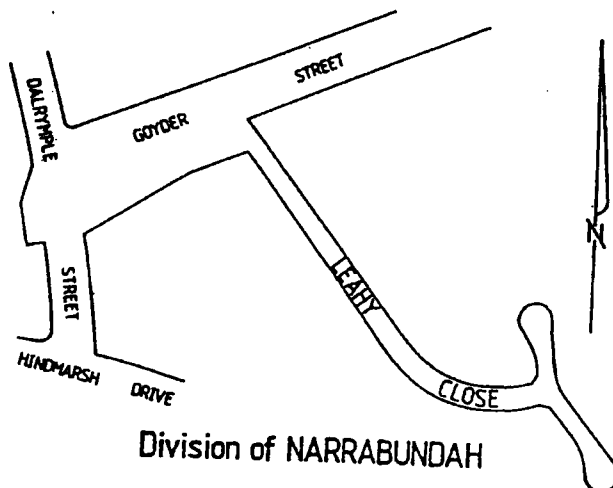
**DIVISION OF NARRABUNDAH: INDIGENOUS NAMES AND EXPLORERS**

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
LEAHY CLOSE	Dan Leahy (1912-1991)	Pioneer and Explorer. He was born in Toowoomba in Queensland in 1912, the eighth of nine children of an Irish immigrant couple. When the Pacific War started, he joined the Australian New Guinea Administrative Unit, which recruited indigenous volunteers and pre-war Australian expatriates in support of the Allied effort. He made several expeditions to rescue expatriates trapped by the Japanese. He earned a place in the history of Papua New Guinea when he and his brother led a 1933 expedition that ranks among the last great encounters between ancient and modern man.
