
SIGNIFICANCE

DUNLOP

Sir Edward (Weary) Dunlop OBE, COA (1907-1993) Doctor and war veteran. Sir Edward was revered by former POWs both for his exploits as a doctor on the notorious Burma -Thailand railway and for his work among veterans in the postwar years. After the war Dunlop rose to prominence in public life as a surgeon of international standing, a medical researcher specialising in the treatment of tropical diseases and campaigner for a host of organisations and charities. He was awarded an OBE in 1947 and a COA in 1987 and was president of the Alcoholism Foundation of Victoria.
