TOBACCO ACT 1927

EXEMPTION

No. 144 of 1993

Under Subsections 10(3) and 12(4) of the Tobacco Act 1927, I, WAYNE BRUCE BERRY, Minister for Health, HEREBY EXEMPT such contracts and agreements between the Australian Cricket Board Incorporated and The Benson and Hedges Company owned by WD and HO Wills (Australia) Limited as are in force at the date of this instrument, from the operation of Subsections 10(1), 12(1) and 12(2) of the Tobacco Act 1927 subject to the following conditions:

- (a) That the display of tobacco advertising shall be confined to one 7 metres long x 0.75 metres high sign positioned each side of the sight screen at both ends of the Manuka Oval in the Australian Capital Territory;
- (b) The display of tobacco advertising referred to in paragraph (a) shall only occur during the conduct of a cricket match between the Prime Minister's XI and the touring South African team on 2 December 1993; and
- (c) That the ACT Cricket Association shall display four 9 metres long x 0.75 metres high anti-smoking signs with two of these signs being positioned square of the wicket on each side of the Manuka Oval in the Australian Capital Territory.
