BOOKMAKERS ACT 1985

DUTIES IN RELATION TO THE MAINTENANCE OF PRESCRIBED EQUIPMENT

Pursuant to subsection 55A(2) of the *Bookmakers Act 1985* (the Act) I direct that the duties to be performed by a person who has been authorised pursuant to subsection 55A(1) of the Act are:

- prior to the commencement of a race meeting ensure that a blank tape is inserted into the lockable voice recording unit and lock the unit using a lock and key;
- ensure the audio tape is marked with the date of the race meeting and identification of the bookmaker;
- ensure the telephone and recording unit are working correctly prior to the commencement of the race meeting by pushing the record button and verifying that the red light comes on;
- the authorised person can inspect any telephone unit being used by a bookmaker on a racecourse during a race meeting;
- at the completion of a race meeting the authorised person shall open the voice recording unit and remove the audio tape;
- . forward the audio tape and betting sheet(s) from each bookmaker to the Chief Steward; and
- erase tapes before being returned to the individual bookmaker.
