TOBACCO ACT 1927

EXEMPTION

NO. 14 OF 1994

Pursuant to sections 10(3) and 12(4) of the *Tobacco Act 1927*, I, WAYNE BRUCE BERRY, Minister for Health, **HEREBY EXEMPT** the existing contract between the New South Wales Rugby League Limited and Rothmans of Pall Mall Pty Ltd, executed on 1 March 1989 and renewed on 26 March 1991, and the existing contract between the Canberra Raiders and Rothmans of Pall Mall Pty Ltd, executed on 1 September 1989, insofar as they relate to the display at the Bruce Stadium of:

- A-frame signage up to 30 metres in length adjacent to the eastern sideline of the playing field and carrying, inter alia, the cigarette brand name "Winfield"; and
- the display of signs painted on the grass in the in-goal area at each end of the playing field including, inter alia, the cigarette brand name "Winfield",

during the conduct of all rugby league matches played at Bruce Stadium in the Australian Capital Territory as part of the Winfield Cup competition from and including the date of this instrument until 31 December 1994, subject to the following conditions, pursuant to section 10(2) of the *Tobacco Act* 1927:

- that previously agreed anti-smoking signage will continue to be displayed;
- that the Raiders will engage in active exploration of increased health promotion opportunities in cooperation with the ACT Health Promotion Fund; and
- that an end-of-year performance report will be provided to the ACT Health Promotion Fund on health promotion initiatives undertaken.
