<i>Permits and Certificates of Competency</i>	
Application for learners permit for either a power crane or a power hoist, or to act as a rigger, dogman, scaffolder or crane chaser	\$28 00
Issue of any certificate of competency as a power crane driver, power hoist driver, rigger, dogman, scaffolder, crane chaser or a certificate as an authorised attendant, other than a certificate signed by the Chief Inspector on the successful completion of a TAFE course approved by the Occupational Health and Safety Registrar	
a) examination	\$38.00
b) Certificate	\$33 00
and where applicant is unsuccessful	
c) re-examination	\$38 00
For the issue of copies of any of the certificates of competency or a certificate as authorised attendants referred to above	\$33.00
<i>Design Review</i>	
Design review of cranes, hoists, lifts, plant, scaffolding and gear	\$32.00 plus \$64 00 per hour
<i>Testing of lifts</i>	\$32.00 plus \$22 00 per hour
Re-testing where initial test has failed inspection	515.00 plus 62.00 per hour
<i>Notification of intention to commence building, excavation or compressed air work</i>	
a) in the case of work, in relation to a single private dwelling-house	\$9.00 for every \$1,000.00 or part thereof by which the cost of the work exceeds \$265,000.00
b) in the case of work not being building work in relation to a single private dwelling house	

(i) where the cost of the work exceeds \$22,000.00 but does not exceed \$210,000.00

\$9.00 for every \$2,000.00 or part thereof the cost of the work exceeds \$22,000.00

(ii) where the cost of the work exceeds \$210,000.00

\$900.00 together with \$1 15 for every \$1,000.00 or part thereof by which the cost of the work exceeds \$210,000.00
