

<b>NAME</b>	<b>ORIGIN</b>	<b>SIGNIFICANCE</b>
Hugh McKay Crescent	Hugh Victor McKay (1865-1926)	Inventor. He invented the Stripper Harvester.
Pomeroy Street	John Pomeroy (1872-1950)	Inventor. He invented the exploding bullet.
Archdall Street	Mervyn Archdall (1884-1957)	Editor of 'The Medical Journal of Australia', 1930-1957. He was in general practice until 1917, when he joined the Australian Imperial Force and went to France. He was a surgeon at the 2nd Australian General Hospital, and he was awarded The Gold Medal of the Federal Council of the British Medical Association in Australia.
Counihan Court	Noel Counihan (1914-1986)	Artist.
McDonnell Close	Aeneas John Lindsay McDonnell (1904-1963)	Artist.
Kay Close	Barry Kay (1933-1985)	Artist.
