



Statute No. 30

FEES STATUTE

Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the *Fees Statute 1995*.

Repeal

2. The Fees Statute (Statute No.8 of the Canberra College of Advanced Education) is repealed.

Interpretation

3. In this Statute, unless the contrary intention appears:

“fees” means:

- (a) fees referred to in section 13 of the Funding Act; or
- (b) any fees or contributions excluded from the definition of “fees” in section 3 of the Funding Act;

“Funding Act” means the *Higher Education Funding Act 1988*.

Rules

4. The Council may make rules, not inconsistent with the Act or a Statute, with respect to the payment to the University of fees.
