
SKIN PENETRATION PROCEDURES ACT 1994

For the purposes of this Schedule the following skin penetration procedures operators  
have been included in the classes:

**Class 1**

An operator who performs a skin penetration procedure for a fee, reward or other  
consideration, other than a person who is exempt under section 13(2) of the Act, or who  
holds a Class 2 operator's licence

**Class 2**

- Emergency services personnel,
- An operator who is also the proprietor of a skin penetration procedures business for  
which a current business licence has been issued;
- Student practitioner who is under the direct supervision of a registered health care  
provider or a licensed operator
