<u>PART 2</u>

CONDITIONS OF PAYMENT OF TRAVELLING ALLOWANCE

- 2 Offices specified in Part 1 of this determination shall be paid travelling allowance in accordance with the following:
 - (a) Travelling allowance at the rate specified shall be payable in respect of each overnight stay away from home for office holders occasioned primarily by official business.
 - (b) An allowance of \$50 shall be payable where travel involves an absence from home of at least 10 hours, but does not involve an overnight stay.
 - (c) Where the absence specified in paragraph (a) exceeds a multiple of 24 hours by at least 10 hours, an extra \$50 shall be payable in addition to the appropriate overnight stay payments.
 - (d) Where the cost of accommodation are met, travelling allowance of \$80 only shall be payable.
 - (e) Where the costs of accommodation and a meal per day are met, travelling allowance of \$65 only shall be payable.
 - (f) Where the costs of accommodation and all meals per day are met, travelling allowance of \$50 only shall be payable.
