

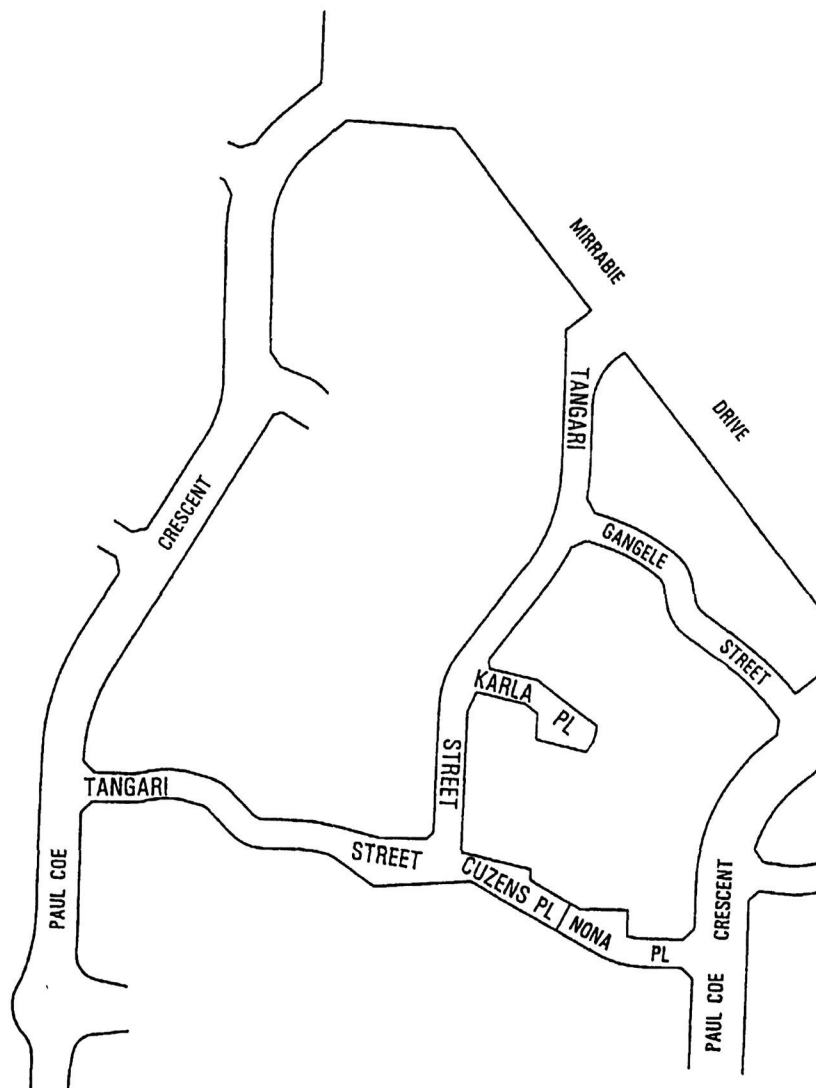
#### **Division of Ngunnawal: Notable Aborigines and Aboriginal Words**

Cuzens Place	James (Jimmy) Cuzens (1847-1890)	One of the star players of the 1868 Aboriginal cricket team that toured England
Kapiu Place	Gagai Kapiu (1901-1960s)	Torres Strait Islander; soldier during WWII
Karla Place		Nyungar word meaning "country" and "homeland"
Lanne Place	William Lanne (1829-1869)	Last known full-blooded Tasmanian male Aborigine
Newbu Place	Newbu (1900-1994)	One of Australia's greatest Aboriginal trackers
Tangari Street		A South Australian Aboriginal word meaning "edible gum"

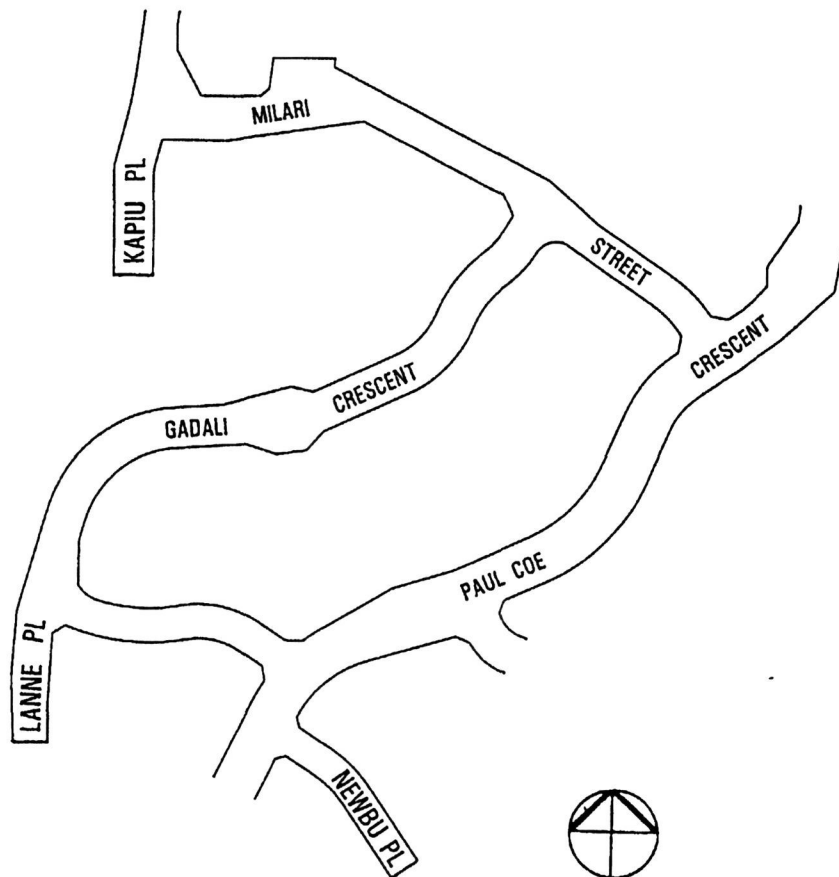


**DIVISION OF NGUNNAWAL**


