

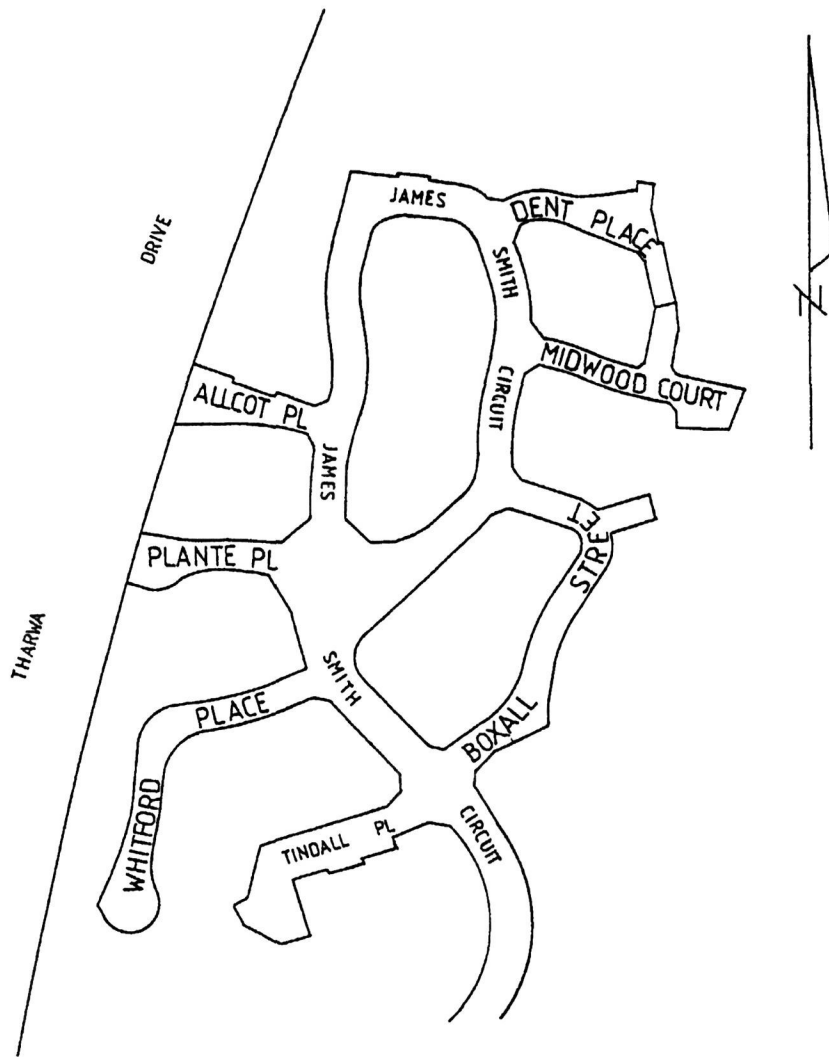

| Dent Place     | Aileen Dent<br>(1890-1979)              | Portrait painter   |
| Midwood Court  | Tom Midwood<br>(1855-1912)              | Prominent cartoonist in Hobart during the late 1800s           |
| Plante Place   | Ada Plante<br>(1875-1950)               | Artist who is remembered for her post impressionist landscapes |
| Whitford Place | Dora Whitford<br>(1898-1969)            | Painter, etcher, commercial artist and stained-glass designer  |
