

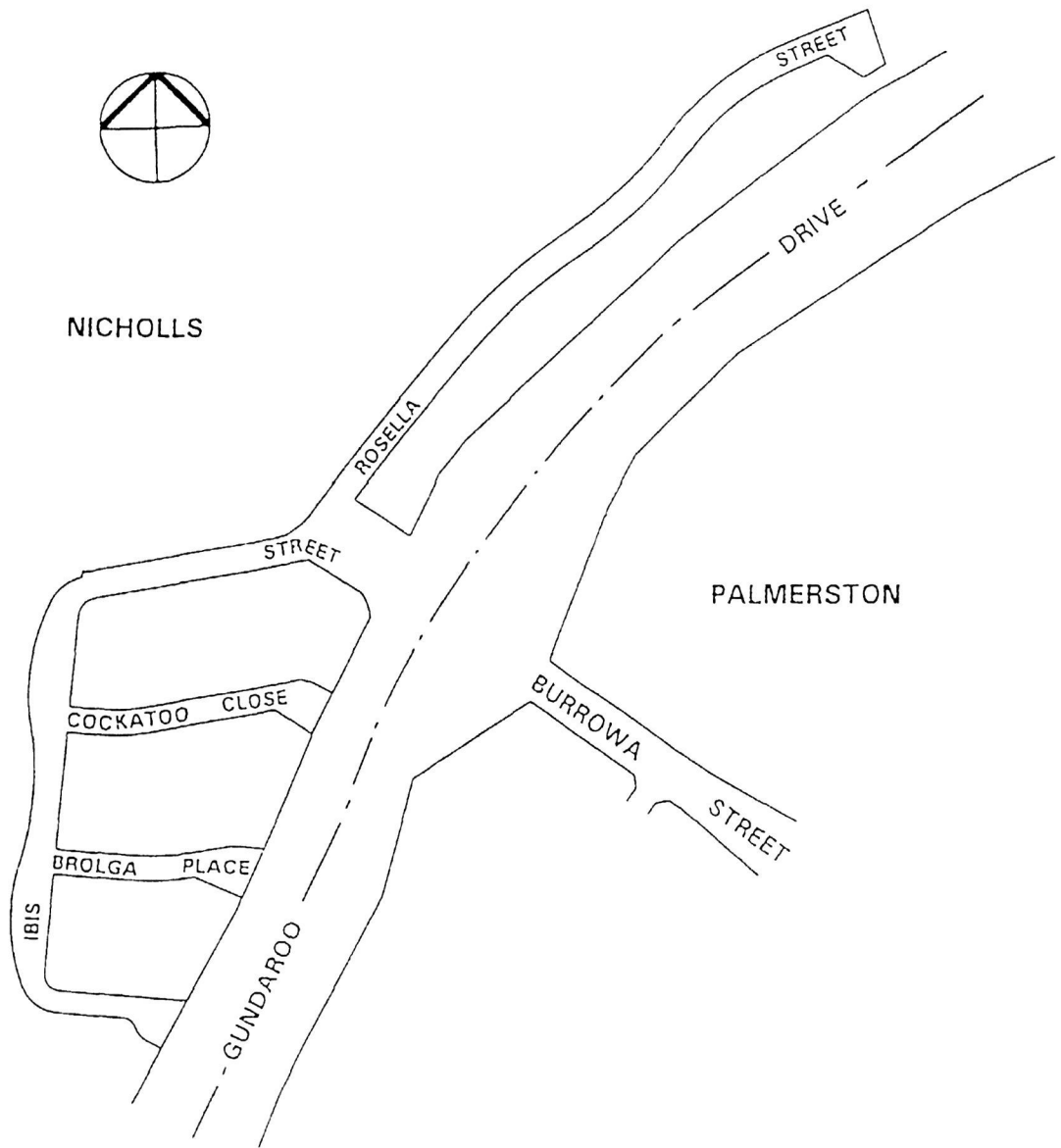

AUSTRALIAN FLORA AND FAUNA

| NAME | ORIGIN | SIGNIFICANCE |
|----------------|---------------------------------------|---|
| Brolga Place | Australian fauna Brolga | The brolga is the only Australian member of the crane family, and is not found anywhere else in the world |
| Cockatoo Close | Australian fauna Cockatoo | All but one of the world's dozen species of cockatoos are native to Australia |
| Ibis Street | Australian fauna Straw-necked Ibis | Australia possesses three species of ibis, the commonest of which is the straw-necked ibis, which is unknown outside Australia |
| Rosella Street | Australian fauna Rosella | Rosella is a derivation of "Rose Hill parrot", the name given by early settlers in Australia to a bird frequently seen in the district of Parramatta, then known as Rose Hill |
