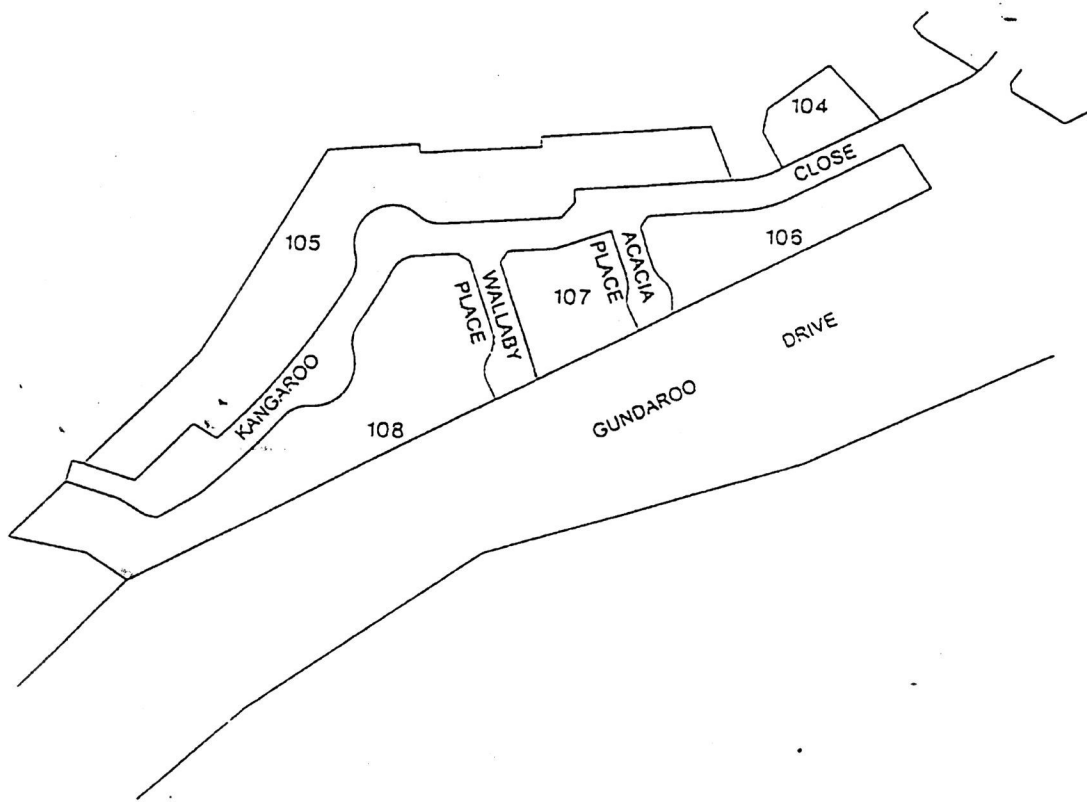


Division of Nicholls: Australian Sportsmen and Sportswomen Australian Flora and Fauna

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Acacia Place	Australia flora: Acacia	Acacia (Wattle) form an important component of the Australian bush, with over 800 species recognised.
Kangaroo Close	Australian Fauna: Kangaroo	Native to Australia the kangaroo is the world's largest marsupial.
Wallaby Place	Australian fauna: Wallaby	A member of the macropodidae family which includes kangaroos, wallaroos and wallabies, the distinction between kangaroos and wallabies is mainly size, wallabies being smaller.
