

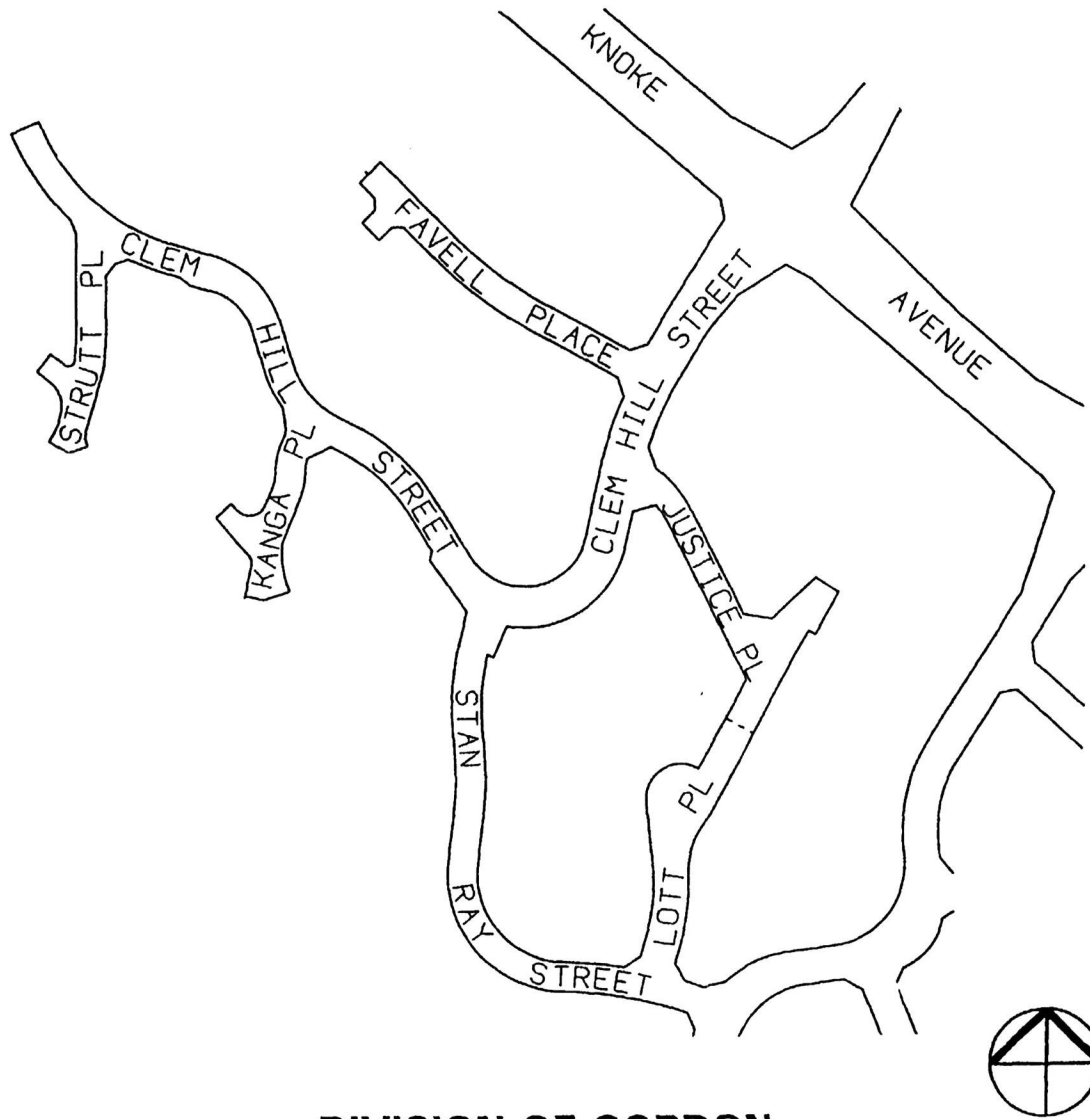

<b>NAME</b>	<b>ORIGIN</b>	<b>SIGNIFICANCE</b>
Clem Hill Street	Clement Hill (1877-1945)	Test Cricketer
Strutt Place	Brigadier Horace William Strutt DSO ED (1903-1985)	Sportsman, notable racing personality, soldier (WWI) Tasmanian politician.
Kanga Place	Wally (Kanga) Prigg (1908-1980)	Rugby League Test Player
Stan Ray Street	Stanley James Lawler Ray OAM (1899-1995)	Sporting official, community leader, author, served in both world wars.
Lott Place	Leslie Francis Maclean Lott (1891-1951) and Olive Francis May Lott (1902-1986)	Early Canberra Residents heavily involved in formation of sporting clubs and bridge. Leslie was an Anzac veteran.
Justice Place	Arthur (Snowy) Justice (1902-1977)	Rugby League Test Player
Favell Place	Leslie Ernest Favell MBE (1929-1987)	Test Cricketer
