



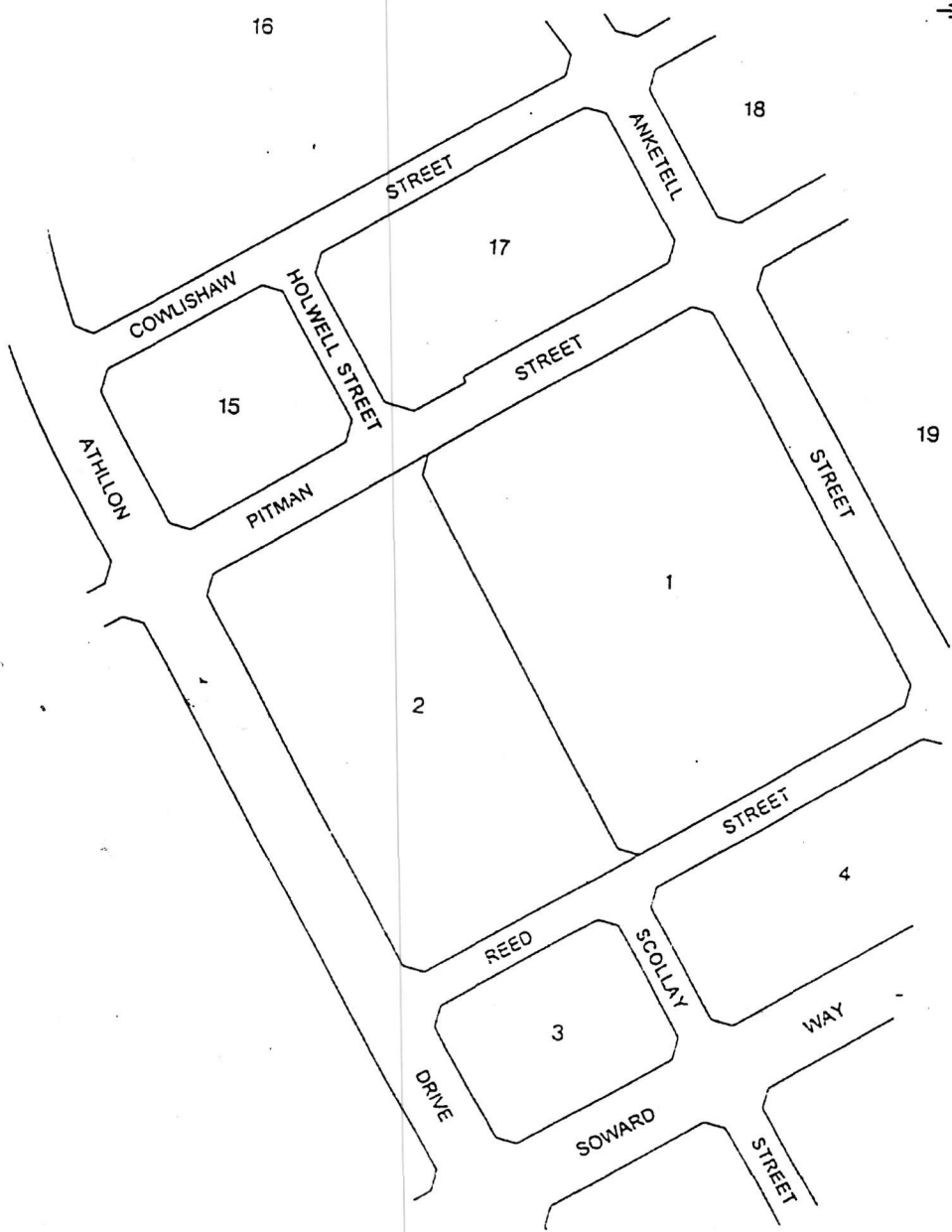
**STREET NOMENCLATURE**

Scollay Street	Edward John Scollay (1918-1985)	Architect. Australian National University Architect 1952-54. First Director Royal Australian Institute of Architects, 1970. Foundation member of ACT Chapter of RAlA and President 1964-66.
Holwell Street	James Kenneth Holwell (1922-1994)	Served with the RAAF in WWII. Supervising Architect (Major Projects) Commonwealth Department of Works, supervising the construction of many of the nation's and Canberra's major buildings.
