## **INSTRUMENT NO. 240 OF 1999**

## **DETERMINATION OF NOTIFIABLE CONDITIONS**

Under subsection 100 (1) of the *Public Health Act 1997*, **I, MICHAEL JOHN MOORE**, Minister for Health and Community Care, make the following determinations for the purposes of that Act.

- 1. The diseases and medical conditions listed in schedule 1 are notifiable conditions (under paragraph 100 (1) (a)).
- 2. The diseases listed in schedule 2 are transmissible notifiable conditions (under paragraph 100 (1) (b)).
