
STREET NOMENCLATURE

Division of Gungahlin: Early Gungahlin district pioneers, homesteads and sites

| NAME | ORIGIN | SIGNIFICANCE |
|----------------|-----------------|----------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------------|
| Bruning Street | Joannes Bruning | Originally from Belgium, a resident of Weetangera in 1860's taking up a farming selection in 1871. |
| Causley Lane | Thomas Causley | Shoemaker and resident of Ginninderra in the 1860's. |
