Under section 96 of the **Road Transport (General) Act 1999** (the Act), I **REVOKE** Instrument No. 78 of 2000, dated 25 February 2000 and notified in the Gazette No. S6 on 29 February 2000, and I **DETERMINE** that the fee payable in respect of the provisions of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulations 2000* (the Regulations), made under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1999*, specified in the attached Schedule shall be the fee specified (including the Commonwealth Goods and Services Tax where indicated by asterisk (\*)) in the Schedule for that provision.

**FORMULA FOR SHORT TERM LICENSING PERIODS**

Where

- A full licence is issued for a period other than five years, or
- A provisional licence is issued for a period other than three years,

The fee payable shall be the five year fee for a full licence divided by sixty and multiplied by the number of months for which the full or provisional licence is issued. Any part of a month shall be treated as one month.
