DETERMINATION OF NON-REFUNDABLE FEES
INSTRUMENT No. 313 OF 2000

Under sub-regulation 14(3) of the *Road Transport (General) Regulations 2000*, made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*, I determine that the fees, charges or other amounts paid to the Road Transport Authority and described in the attached schedule are non-refundable.

This instrument will come into force on 1 October 2000.

The following fees, charges or other amounts paid under the Road Transport Legislation are determined as not refundable under sub-regulation 14(3) of the *Road Transport (General) Regulations 2000*:

- Registration fees or charges where registration is cancelled by the Authority;
- Road Rescue Fee, except where the registration is surrendered by the registered operator before the start date of the new registration period for which the Road Rescue Fee was paid;
- Inspection fees for motor vehicles and trailers;
- Additional fees paid for original vehicle registration;
- Additional fees paid for the issue or renewal of registration for periods of less than 12 months;
- Registration transfer fees, including the 'late transfer' fee;
- Unregistered vehicle permit fees – regardless of whether the permit is surrendered before it has commenced;
- Fees for replacing a registration certificate or registration label;
- Fees for replacing an identification label (Traders);
- Fees for swapping, exchanging or remaking number plates;
- Fees for the reservation of rights to non-standard registration numbers, unless the order is cancelled within 3 days of the date of the order;
- Fees for assigning the rights to non-standard registration numbers;
- Fees for the storage of plates with non-standard registration numbers;
- Fees for certified extracts from vehicle registration or driver licensing records;
- Fees for searches of vehicle registration or driver licensing records;
- Fees for changing a practical driving test booking;
- Fees for cancelling a driving test if the test is cancelled within 48 hours of the agreed time for the test;
- Fees for replacing a driver licence;
- Fee for copy of lost or destroyed certificate of appointment as authorised examiner;
- Fee for copy of lost or destroyed certificate of approval of authorised premises.
