DRIVERS' LICENCES

Under section 96 of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* (the Act), I determine that the fee payable in respect of the provisions of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulations 2000* (the Regulations), made under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Act 1999*, specified in the attached Schedule shall be the fee specified in the Schedule for that provision.

This Determination commences on the commencement of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*.

SHORT-TERM LICENCE FORMULA

Where:

- a full licence is granted for any period other than five years, or
- a provisional licence is granted for any period other than three years,

the fee payable shall be the five year fee for a full licence divided by sixty and multiplied by the number of months for which the full or provisional licence has been granted. Any part of any month shall be treated as one month.
