## **INSTRUMENT NO. 90 OF 2000**

## APPROVAL OF CHILD RESTRAINTS

I, David Handley pursuant to the functions delegated to me under section 17(1) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999 (the Act)* and in particular the function of the Road Transport Authority to approve child restraints under sub regulation 66 of the Road Transport ( Safety and Traffic Management ) Regulations 2000 (*the Regulations*) approve that:

The following are kinds of child restraints that the Road Transport Authority states are suitable:

- 1. A child restraint that is marked with the letters "AS 1754", or
- A child restraint that is marked with the certification trade mark registered under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth in respect of child restraints and Australian Standard 1754-1975.

This instrument commences operation on 1 March 2000.
