**APPROVAL OF PROTECTIVE HELMETS FOR
MOTORBIKE RIDERS**

I, David Handley pursuant to the functions delegated to me under section 17(1) of the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999 (the Act)* and in particular the function of the Road Transport Authority to approve protective helmets for motorbike riders under sub regulation 66 of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000 (*the Regulations*) approve that:

The following are kinds of protective helmets for motorbike riders that the Road Transport Authority states are suitable:

1. A protective helmet that has applied to it the certification trade mark of which the Standards Association of Australia is the registered proprietor under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth together with the letter and figures "E33";
2. A protective helmet that has applied to it the certification trade mark of which the Standards Association of Australia is the registered proprietor under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth together with the letter and figures "E43";
3. A protective helmet that has applied to it the certification trade mark of which the Standards Association of Australia is the registered proprietor under the Trade Marks Act 1955 of the Commonwealth together with the letter and figures "1698";
4. A protective helmet that has applied to it the letters and figures "AS E33" or the letters and figures "AS E43".

This instrument commences operation on 1 March 2000.
