

## DIVISION NAME WITH REFERENCE TO ORIGIN

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Bonner	Neville Bonner AO (1922-1999)	An elder of the south-east Queensland Jagera people. In 1971 Neville Bonner became the first Indigenous Australian to be elected to Federal Parliament. After serving 12 years as a Senator, he went on to hold a series of prominent positions, serving as a director on the on the board of the ABC, as the senior official visitor for all Queensland prisons and as head of the Indigenous Advisory Council – the peak body advising the Queensland Government on indigenous issues. He was awarded the Order of Australia (1984) and in 1979 the Australia Day Council named him Australian of the Year.
