Public Health Risk (Health Care Facilities) Declaration 2001

1 Name of declaration

This declaration is the *Public Health Risk* (Health Care Facilities) Declaration 2001.

2 Commencement

This declaration commences 30 days from the day this declaration is notified in the Gazette.

3 Definitions

In this declaration—

health care facility means a premises upon which prescribed medical and dental procedures are carried out and/or a premise in which over night patient stays are provided, but does not include an aged care facility.

prescribed medical and dental procedures means procedures undertaken for medical or cosmetic reasons by a health care professional that involves:

- (a) the administration of a general, spinal, epidural or major regional block anaesthetic or intravenous sedative for the purpose of performing an elective procedure, but does not include mandibular blocks;
- (b) endoscopy;
- (c) dialysis, haemofiltration or haemoperfusion;
- (d) prolonged intravenous infusion of a single cytotoxic agent or sequential intravenous infusion of more than one cytotoxic agent; or
- (e) cardiac catheterisation.

4 Health Care Facilities—public health risk activities

It is a licensable public health risk activity to operate, manage or control a business, charity or service that is a *health care facility*.

5 Revocation of Private Hospital—public health risk activities

I hereby revoke the previous *Private Hospital Public Health Risk Declaration 2000* (Instrument No. 346 of 2000).

6 Saving —Private Hospital licensed before commencement of this instrument

A Private Hospital licensed under the *Public Health Act* 1997 before the commencement of this instrument is taken to be licensed as a Health Care Facility under the *Public Health Act* 1997 at the commencement this instrument until the expiration of that Private Hospital Licence.

7 Saving —Skin Penetration Procedures licensed before commencement of this instrument

A business licensed under the *Skin Penetration Procedures Act* 1994 before the commencement of this instrument is taken to be a licensed as a Health Care Facility under the *Public Health Act* 1997 at the commencement this instrument until the expiration of that Skin Penetration Procedure Licence.
