DOG CONTROL ACT 1975

DETERMINATION FEES

INSTRUMENT NO. 19 OF 2001

Pursuant to section 40A of the Dog Control Act 1975 (the Act), I determine that the fee payable for the purpose of the initial registration of a dog, as required under section 9 of the Act, and as described in Column 1, shall be the fee specified in Column 2. This determination applies only to applications for the initial registration of a dog made within the grounds of Exhibition Park Canberra during the period 23 February 2001 to 25 February 2001 inclusive, and does not otherwise affect the operation of any other determination.

The fee for the initial registration of a dog by a keeper the benefit of a discounted fee is: in the case of a pension/benefit recipient who is a keeper of a dog which is sterilised.	Nil
