Citation

1. This Statute may be cited as the *Courses and Awards Amendment Statute 2001*.

Interpretation

2. In this Statute:

Principal Statute means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute

insert “Bachelor of Arts in English for Professional Purposes”;
 - (b) after “Bachelor of Management”,
insert “Bachelor of New Media Production”;
 - (c) after “Bachelor of Tourism”,
insert “Bachelor of Tourism Management”;
 - (d) omit “Master of Advertising and Public Relations”,
insert “Master of Advanced Nursing Practice
Master of Advertising and Public Relations”;
 - (e) after “Master of Corporate Law”,
insert “Master of Counselling Psychology”;
 - (f) omit “Master of International Finance”,
insert “Master of International Finance
Master of Internet Communication
Master of Knowledge Management”;
 - (g) after “Master of Library and Information Management”,
insert “Master of Management in Defence Studies”;
 - (h) after “Master of Public Administration”,
insert “Master of Sports Management”;
 - (i) after “Master of Taxation”,
insert “Master of Tourism Management”;
 - (j) omit “Doctor of Public Administration”,
insert “Doctor of Public Administration
Doctor of Urban Management”.

Amendment of section 4 of the Principal Statute

4. Section 4 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:
 - (a) after “Graduate Diploma in Education”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Electronic Business”;
 - (b) after “Graduate Diploma in Information Systems”,

- insert “Graduate Diploma in Information Technology”;
- (c) after “Graduate Diploma in Professional Development Education”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Property”;
- (d) after “Graduate Diploma in Recreation Planning”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Regional and Local Government Management”;
- (e) after “Graduate Diploma in Special Education”,
insert “Graduate Diploma in Sports Management”.

Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute

5. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) omit “Graduate Certificate in Education”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Education
Graduate Certificate in Electronic Business
Graduate Certificate in Employment Relations”;
- (b) after “Graduate Certificate in Information Access and Delivery”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Information Technology”;
- (c) omit “Graduate Certificate in Marketing Communication”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Marketing Communication
Graduate Certificate in Performance Auditing
Graduate Certificate in Photonic Engineering”;
- (d) after “Graduate Certificate in Regional and Local Government
Management”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Sports Management”;
- (e) after “Graduate Certificate in Technology Enhanced Language
Learning”,
insert “Graduate Certificate in Urban Management”.
