

Midwinter Place	William Midwinter (1851-1890)	Australian Cricketer. William was born in England, coming to Australia at an early age. An all round cricketer, he was a right-handed batsman, medium-paced spin bowler and first-rate outfielder. He appeared in the inaugural Test at Melbourne, taking 5 for 78 in England's first inning. He was a member of the first Australian side of 1878 and toured England as a member of the Australian side in 1884. He ended his Test career for Australia in the 1886- 87 series.
