

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Chalmers Place	Reverend James Chalmers (1841-1901)	Missionary and Explorer.
		James Chalmers was born in 1841 in the bwn of Ardishaig, Scotland. James studied theology at Cheshunt College from 1859 and was ordained in 1865. With his new wife, James took up his first missionary appointment in Rarotonga arriving in 1867. The natives named him 'Tamate'. He was known by this name until his death.
		The Rarotonga Christian mission was well established. He reorganised an existing Training Institution and set about educating native children.
		James encouraged self-government and independence of European influence once a native work was well established. He wrote: "So long as the native churches have foreign pastors, so long will they remain weak and dependent."
		In 1877 James was assigned to New Guinea which was, at the time, a largely unexplored island. Besides introducing the gospel, James accomplished the seemingly impossible goal of promoting peace among the tribes all along the coast.
		In November 1884 New Guinea was formally annexed as a territory of Great Britain. James was enormously successful in smoothing over native resistance to the Protectorate.
		James was brutally murdered during a missionary trip to Goaribari Island in April 1901. The news of his murder made headlines all over the world.
