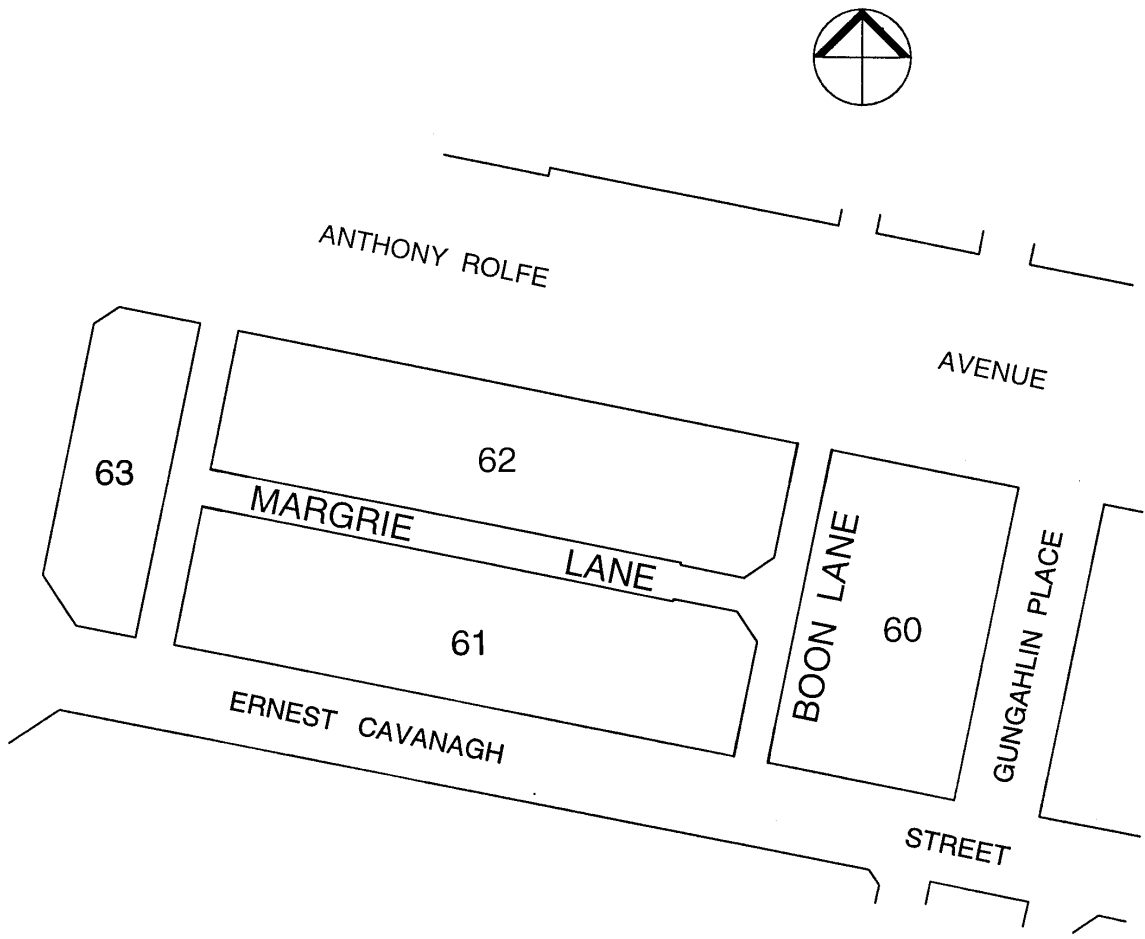

NAME	ORIGIN	SIGNIFICANCE
Boon Lane	The Boon Family David Boon (1836-1912) Mary Anne Boon <i>nee</i> <i>Gutteridge</i> (1836- 1906)	Gungahlin Pioneers David Boon arrived in the colony on the ship called the <i>John Bunyan</i> on 27 October 1857. He and Mary Ann Plummer married at Camden in 1860. The couple lived in the Campbelltown area until about 1870 when they moved to Weetangera in what is now known as the ACT. David established himself as a farmer growing some of the finest wheat in Australia. David and Mary Anne were leading members of the Wesleyan Church where David taught and acted as Superintendent of the Sunday School. David was a member of the Ginninderra Cricket Club. Together they raised 10 children: David William (1861-1925) Lucy (1862-1960) Arthur Levi (1866-) Frances Mary Ann (1868-) Eliza May (1871-1946) Ada Ruth (1873-1951) Frederick John (1875-1959) Ernest Lliwellin (1877-1941) Isaac Walter (1879-1946) Clement Edward (1881-1937)
Margrie Lane	Henry William Margrie (1861-) Evalina Jane Margrie (<i>nee</i> Gale) (1858-1938)	Gungahlin Pioneers Evelina Gale, born at Bland Plains and Henry (Harry) William Margrie were married on 12 October 1883 in Queanbeyan, NSW. Henry was the teacher at Jeir and Bedellick Half-Time Schools in 1880 to 1882. He subsequently taught at various other schools in the region including Demondrille, Collector and Tharwa.
