Approval of Protective Helmets for Bicycle Riders 2001

Disallowable Instrument DI 4 2002

made under the

Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management), Regulations 2000, section 66 Approvals etc by Road Transport Authority

Pursuant to regulation 66 of the Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) Regulations 2000, I, Alan Geoffrey Thompson, the person for the time being performing the duties of the Government Service which includes the position of Chief Executive of the Road Transport Authority, do hereby revoke the instrument “APPROVAL OF PROTECTIVE HELMETS FOR BICYCLE RIDERS” dated 1 March 2000, Gazettal No. 11, 16 March 2000, and approve the following kinds of protective helmets for bicycle riders.

1. A protective helmet for bicycle riders that is marked with the certification trade mark registered under the *Trade Marks Act 1955* of the Commonwealth in respect of pedal cycle helmets and Australian Standard 2063:1996.
2. A protective helmet that has a Snell Memorial Foundation serialised certification label placed either inside or outside of the helmet in respect of Snell Standard, 1995 Standard For Protective Headgear For Use In Bicycling.
