Firearms (Fees) Determination 2003 (No 1)

Disallowable instrument DI2003—261

made under the

Firearms Act 1996, s 125 (Determination of fees)

1 Determination

I determine that a fee is not payable under disallowable instrument no 264 of 1998 for the following applications under the Act:

- (a) an application by a person to whom the Act, section 135 (Compensation for surrendered prohibited pistols—licensed pistol shooters) applies—
 - (i) for a permit authorising the person to acquire a pistol (other than a prohibited pistol) (the *replacement pistol*) as a replacement for the prohibited pistol surrendered under that section; or
 - (ii) for the registration by the person of the replacement pistol;
- (b) an application by a person to whom the Act, section 134 (Temporary licensing and registration amnesty for pre-1900 percussion pistols) applies—
 - (i) for the issue of a licence to the person for the genuine reason of firearms collection; or
 - (ii) for the registration by the person of a pre-1900 percussion-fired pistol (within the meaning of that section) acquired by the person before 1 July 2003.

2 Expiry of instrument

This instrument expires on 31 March 2004.
