Manuka - area bound by and with frontages to, Franklin Street (Nth side) between Furneaux St and Flinders Way, Flinders Way (West side) between Franklin St and Bougainville St, Bougainville St (Nth side) between Flinders Way and Furneaux St, Furneaux St (East side) between Bougainville St and Franklin St.
