5.2 Customer Consent

New sub-clause 5.2 (b)

insert

- (b) For the avoidance of doubt, clause 5.2(a) also applies where a Customer is transferring the terms of supply from an Electricity Supplier's Standard Customer Contract to a Negotiated Customer Contract with the same Electricity Supplier.

New sub-clause 5.2(c)(3)(ii)

insert

- ii. in a form that would meet the requirements of the *Electronic Transactions Act 2001*.

“Negotiated Customer Contract means a contract that is a Negotiated Customer Contract for the purposes of Part 6 of the Act”;

“Standard Customer Contract” means a contract that is a Standard Customer Contract for the purposes of Part 6 of the Act”.
