3. This instrument amends the Attorney-General (Fees) Determination 2004 (DI 2004-106) as amended.

Amendments

4. Amend Schedule 2 of the instrument to replace 207 with the following

207.1	On lodging: (a) an application for admission to practice or for enrolment under the Legal Practitioners Act 1970; or (b) a notice seeking registration in an occupation under the Mutual Recognition Scheme.	\$ 263.00
	Explanatory Note: Note that registration in an occupation under the Mutual Recognition Scheme would include registration as a notary public under that scheme. Last Financial Year the Fees were \$257.00.	
207.2	On lodging an application or notice under Item 207.1.	\$ 125.00
	Explanatory Note: This is a new charge for a co-contribution scheme towards the costs of the Supreme Court Library.
