* Notes:

The fee for a security sensitive substances licence for a single activity (excluding manufacture) is set at \$84.55. Where a licence is issued for multiple security sensitive licence activities (via the same application and transaction), the fee for the second and subsequent activities is set at \$42.25.

Examples:

1. A person applies for and is issued with a 'security sensitive substances supply licence'. Cost of the licence is \$84.55 per year.
2. A person applies for and is issued with a 'security sensitive substances supply licence' and a 'security sensitive substances storage licence'. Cost of the licence is \$126.80 per year (\$84.55 + \$42.25).

3. A person applies for and is issued with a 'security sensitive substances supply licence', a 'security sensitive substances storage licence' and a 'security sensitive substances carrying licence'. Cost of the licence is \$169.05 per year (\$84.55 + \$42.25 + \$42.25).
4. A person applies for and is issued with a 'security sensitive substances supply licence'. The cost of the licence is \$84.55 per year. Later, the person applies for a 'security sensitive substances storage licence'. The cost of that licence is also \$84.55 per year.
