(f)	before 'Master of Advanced Nursing Practice' insert Executive Master of Public Administration and Juris Doctor
(g)	after 'Master of Bioethics' insert Master of Business
(h)	after 'Master of Business Administration' insert Master of Business Informatics and Master of Child, Youth and Family Nursing
(i)	after 'Master of Industrial Design'

insert Master of Information Sciences

- (j) after 'Master of Information Technology' insert Master of Information Technology in Business Informatics Master of Information Technology in Information Systems Master of Information Technology in Network Computing and Master of Information Technology in Software Engineering
- (k) after 'Master of Taxation' insert **Master of Technology**
- (l) after 'Doctor of Environmental Design' insert **Doctor of Information Sciences**
