3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

after 'Master of International Customs Law and Administration' insert **Master of International Economic Law**

Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute

- 4. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:
 - (a) after 'Graduate Certificate in Cancer Nursing' insert Graduate Certificate in Child, Youth and Family Nursing
 - (b) after 'Graduate Certificate in Community Health Promotion' insert Graduate Certificate in Critical Care Nursing
 - (c) after 'Graduate Certificate in Higher Education' insert Graduate Certificate in Human Movement Science
 - (d) after 'Graduate Certificate in Marketing Communication' insert Graduate Certificate in Neonatal Nursing

Amendment of section 7 of the Principal Statute

5. Section 7 of the Principal Statute is amended by omitting subsections (2) and (3) and inserting the following:

"(2) A course of study declared under subsection (1) is taken to be specified as a course of study in the *Courses and Awards (Courses of Study) Rules 2005.*"
