**University of Canberra (Courses and Awards) Amendment Statute 2005 (No 2)**

**Citation**

1. This Statute may be cited as the *University of Canberra (Courses and Awards) Amendment Statute 2005 (No 2)*.

**Interpretation**

2. In this Statute:

*Principal Statute* means the *Courses and Awards Statute 1995*.

**Amendment of section 3 of the Principal Statute**

3. Section 3 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

after ‘Master of International Customs Law and Administration’  
insert **Master of International Economic Law**

**Amendment of section 5 of the Principal Statute**

4. Section 5 of the Principal Statute is amended as follows:

- (a) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Cancer Nursing’  
insert **Graduate Certificate in Child, Youth and Family Nursing**
- (b) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Community Health Promotion’  
insert **Graduate Certificate in Critical Care Nursing**
- (c) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Higher Education’  
insert **Graduate Certificate in Human Movement Science**
- (d) after ‘Graduate Certificate in Marketing Communication’  
insert **Graduate Certificate in Neonatal Nursing**

**Amendment of section 7 of the Principal Statute**

5. Section 7 of the Principal Statute is amended by omitting subsections (2) and (3) and inserting the following:

“(2) A course of study declared under subsection (1) is taken to be specified as a course of study in the *Courses and Awards (Courses of Study) Rules 2005*.”
