SCHEDULE

This is the schedule referred to in the determination of criteria for the approval of nurse practitioner positions made under section 5 of the *Health Regulation 2004*.

Criteria for the approval of nurse practitioner positions

- The establishment of a nurse practitioner position will address identified consumer health service needs
- The role is developed in collaboration with the community and those in the current service
- Adequate resources for establishment and maintenance of the service are provided
- A broad description of the role and scope of practice of the nurse practitioner in the health service and a plan for the development of specific clinical practice guidelines are included in the proposal to establish the position
- Comprehensive corporate and clinical governance strategies are identified in relation to the position.
