

Building (Asbestos code – asbestos removal control plan) Determination 2006

Disallowable instrument DI2006—174

made under the

***Building Act 2004*, s 139B (1) (Asbestos code)**

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Building (Asbestos code –asbestos removal control plan) Determination 2006*.

2 Commencement

This instrument commences the day after notification.

3 Asbestos code

In accordance with section 139B (1) of the *Building Act 2004* (the Act), I approve the following as the asbestos code for the purposes of section 29 (1) (d) of the Act.

The code of practice for an *asbestos removal control plan* (as defined by the Act) is that the *asbestos removal control plan* is to contain, as a minimum, the following information-

- the method proposed to be used to remove the asbestos;
- the approximate quantity and kind of asbestos to be removed;
- the equipment proposed to be used to remove the asbestos, including any personal protective equipment; and
- details of a program (prepared in accordance with the *NOHSC Code of Practice for the Safe Removal of Asbestos*, published by the Office of the Australian Safety and Compensation Council) for monitoring airborne asbestos.
