

## Road Transport (General) (Driver Licensing) Exemption 2006 (No 1)

### Disallowable Instrument DI 2006 - 20

made under the

**Road Transport (General) Act 1999, Section 13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)**

#### **1 Name of instrument**

This instrument is the Road Transport (General) (Driver Licensing) Exemption 2006 (No 1).

#### **2 Commencement**

This instrument commences on the day after notification.

#### **3 Exemptions**

AFP officers who are not the holders of a motorcycle licence and who are undertaking or have successfully completed the Pursuit Motorcycle Course, leading to an AFP Driving Permit that authorises them to ride a police pursuit motorcycle, are exempt from the following provisions of the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 2000*:

- Regulation 16(3) – relating to undertaking an approved road ready training course and an approved pre-learner rider training course;
- Regulation 20(1)(a) – relating to riding a motorcycle with a power to weight ratio over 150 kW/tonne;
- Regulation 20(2) – relating to the display of L plates;
- Regulation 28(2)(a) – relating to holding a learner motorcycle licence for at least 3 months; and
- Regulation 29 and Division 3.4 – relating to the holding of, and requirements of, a provisional motorcycle licence.
