# Road Transport (General) (Application of Road Transport Legislation) Declaration 2006 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2006—22

made under the

**Road Transport (General) Act 1999, s13 (Power to exclude vehicles, persons or animals from road transport legislation)**

## 1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) (Application of Road Transport Legislation) Declaration 2006 (No 2)*.

## 2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 10 February 2006.

*Note* Under s 74 of the *Legislation Act 2001* an instrument commences at the beginning of a day unless otherwise specified.

## 3 Declaration

I declare that the road transport legislation does not apply to a vehicle or driver of a vehicle participating in a ‘green’ special stage of the Subaru Rally of Canberra Launch and Sponsors’ Day on 10 February 2006 (“the special stage”).

A special stage commences when an event official declares the special stage active for high speed driving and ceases when an event official declares that special stage closed.

The special stages are conducted over those roads marked as “competitive stage” on the map at Attachment A.

#### **4 Expiry**

This declaration expires on 10 February 2006.

*Note* Under s 85 of the *Legislation Act 2001* an instrument that is repealed continues in force until the end of the day of the repeal.

#### **5 Definitions**

For this declaration, an *event official* means an official of the Subaru Rally of Canberra Launch and Sponsors' Day
