


REVOKE	DISTRICT	REASON
Wells Station Drive	Gungahlin	To correct the spelling of the road name in line with the accurate spelling of Well Station Homestead.

SCHEDULE B

NAME	DISTRICT	SIGNIFICANCE
Well Station Drive	Gungahlin	These roads commemorate the historic Well Station Homestead. The homestead was named after the single 'well' on the property. The homestead became known as Wells Station, an error that has been perpetuated over time.
