SCHEDULE

RULES OF THE TRIBUNAL

1. Bond

- 1.1 A bond must be lodged when an appeal is lodged with the registrar of the tribunal.
- 1.2 The amount of the bond to be lodged with the tribunal, as required by clause 1.1, is \$500.00.
- 1.3 The bond must not be refunded, in full or part, unless ordered by the tribunal.

2. Withdrawal of Appeal

- 2.1 An appeal lodged with the tribunal may not be withdrawn except with the leave of the tribunal.
- 2.2 In granting or refusing such leave, the tribunal may impose such conditions as it thinks fit, including the payment of costs.
- 2.3 In granting or refusing such leave, the tribunal must order that the bond be forfeited or refunded, either in full or in part.
