1. Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Water Resources (Water management areas) Determination* 2007 (No 1).

2. Commencement

This instrument commences on 1 August 2007

3. Determination of water management areas




Figure 1: Map showing water management areas.

Water management areas are shown in the map in Figure 1. Water management areas include one or more sub-catchment areas, as provided for by the water resources management plan (see Volume 3 *Think water, act water*) that was prepared under the repealed *Water Resources Act 1998* – as shown in Table 1.

4. Explanatory Notes

The boundaries of water management areas are based on watersheds. Where these do not line up with the ACT border, the water management areas are shown to extend into NSW. The ACT has rights to water from the Googong Dam Area, located in the Googong catchment in NSW, and has responsibility for managing that area. The inclusion of an area in NSW in Figure 1 is done to assist understanding and does not imply that the ACT has any rights or responsibilities in that area.
