

Ibbott Lane	Dame Nellie Grace Ibbott OBE (1889-1970)	Mayor
		Dame Nellie Ibbot was born in Scotland in 1889. She migrated to Australia in 1923 with her husband Alfred Ibbott.
		Nellie took an active part in Victorian public affairs. She became a member of the local branch of the (then) United Australian Party. Nellie was horrified at the state of the roads and later stood for election to Council on this issue.
		In 1943 when Nellie became Mayor of the City of Heidelberg she was the first woman to be elected mayor in Victoria.
		Nellie was made a member of The Order of the British Empire - Member (Civil) in 1954 for her work in local government & charities.
