1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the *Road Transport (General) (Application of Road Transport Legislation) Declaration 2008 (No 3).*

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 19 March 2008.

3 Declaration

I declare that the road transport legislation does not apply to ACT roads or road related areas used or impinged on by any competing vehicle participating in the Brindabella Motor Sport Club pace note training day.

This declaration has effect during the competitive special stages of the event.

This declaration expires on 20 March 2008.

For this declaration, the following definitions apply:

Competing vehicle means:

Any vehicle used for participating in a special stage of the event.

Event means:

Brindabella Motor Sport Club pace note training day on 19 March 2008.

Special stage means:

The period from the time when an event official declares a special stage active for the training day until the time when an event official declares course control for that special stage closed.

The special stage for training purposes is shown on the attached maps:

• Special Stage – Sherwood Forest.
