

Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) (Authorised Fixed Fare Hiring) Approval 2008 (No 2)

Disallowable instrument DI2008–39

made under the

Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) Regulation 2002, section 142A (Exemption from operation of taximeter and metered fares for certain hirings – Act, s 85(1))

1 Name of instrument

This instrument is the Road Transport (Public Passenger Services) (Authorised Fixed Fare Hiring) Approval 2008 (No 2).

2 Commencement

This instrument commences on 20 March 2008.

3 Approval

I approve a hiring carried out by a Nightlink taxi between midnight on Fridays and 6.00am on Saturdays, or between midnight on Saturdays and 6.00am on Sundays, and between midnight to 6.00am on 21 March 2008, to be an authorised fixed fare hiring.

4 Revocation

I revoke Disallowable Instrument DI2008-29 as notified on 28 February 2008.

5 Definitions for instrument

Nightlink taxi – is a taxi that seats six (6) or more people (including the driver); displays a decal that includes the words ‘Nightlink taxi’; and is operated by an accredited taxi service operator affiliated with Aerial Consolidated Transport Limited trading as Canberra Cabs, or Aerial Transport Solutions Pty Ltd trading as Canberra Elite Taxis and Canberra Silver Service, or is operated by an accredited restricted taxi service operator of a NSW cross-border taxi.
