#### 1. Name of instrument

This instrument is the Legal Profession (Bar Council Fees) Determination 2008 (No 1).

#### 2. Commencement

This instrument commences on the day after it is notified.

#### 3. Determination of fees

The fee payable for an application for the grant or renewal of a barrister practising certificate, for the level of seniority listed in Column 1 of the attached Schedule, is the amount listed for that item in Column 2 of that Schedule.

#### 4. Payment of fee

A fee listed in the Schedule is payable to the ACT Bar Association by the person requesting the barrister practising certificate.

A fee may be paid by instalments if the person requesting the barrister practising certificate makes a written request to do so and the ACT Bar Association agrees in writing.

### 5. Goods and services tax

Barrister practising certificate fees are exempt from payment of GST.

## 6. Revocation

This instrument revokes Disallowable Instrument number DI2007 – 112.
